RE: Rancho Mirage Energy Authority Implementation and Impact on your Participation in Southern California Edison's Peak Time Rebate Program

Dear <Customer Name>:

As you may be aware, the City of Rancho Mirage is in the process of launching Rancho Mirage Energy Authority (RMEA), a program that provides cheaper, greener, energy to Rancho Mirage's residents and businesses. Beginning in May 2018, Rancho Mirage Energy Authority will replace Southern California Edison (SCE) as your default energy provider, with rates 5% lower than SCE's current generation rates and from 50% carbon free sources.

In 2002, the California legislature authorized cities and/or counties to procure electricity for consumers within their respective jurisdictions. SCE continues to be responsible for the transmission and delivery systems and for delivering the power to homes and businesses receiving Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) service, such as RMEA. SCE and RMEA will work together to ensure the reliability of your electric service will not change and there will be no duplicative charges or costs related to your service.

Currently, you are participating in SCE's optional Peak Time Rebate (PTR) program. This program is not available to Rancho Mirage Energy Authority customers. If you do not opt-out, and choose to receive electric generation services from RMEA, your account will be automatically removed from PTR effective with the transition to RMEA service in May 2018.

Rate Definitions

Rancho Mirage Energy Authority (RMEA) customers receive Delivery service from SCE and purchase energy from RMEA. SCE will read the meters and present the bill for both Delivery service and Generation to the RMEA service customer. The customer's bill is the sum of the charges for Delivery service determined by SCE and Generation charges determined by RMEA plus any applicable charges as shown in SCE Schedule CCA-CRS.

PTR: Peak Time Rebate is an optional event-based program that provides compensation in the form of monthly bill credits to customers who reduce kWh usage below their Customer Specific Reference Level (CSRL) during PTR Events.
